Public Recognition given to Mary Ward: On 19th Dec. 09 his Holiness, Pope Benedict XVI, promulgated the Decreee conferring on Mary Ward the title "Venerable", which enables her cause to go forward to the next stage in the process of beatifiction and eventual canonization.

It gives us tremendous joy to hear Mary Ward publicly acclaimed by the Church as 'Venerable' and a woman of "heroic virtue" - a belief which has sustained Mary's companions and subsequent members through the long years past. It is our turn now to witness to heroic virtues! The story goes on...

Celebration in Bangladesh in honour of Mary Ward's 400 years:

Dec 3rd was reserved for making Mary Ward and IBVM known to the Clergy and Religious of Bangladesh. So well was this purpose fulfilled, and so high was the appreciation of 'Loreto' that priests of different dioceses and parishes in Bangladesh were making earnest requests to us to come to their parish and work with the people there!! Besides the evidence of the good training of the students and the whole hearted involvement of the teachers and parishioners in the day's programme - which consisted of a meaningful Eucharistic liturgy, a short variety programme, an exhibition and DVD on Mary Ward, and lunch for all – we were

pleasantly surprised to hear the Bishop of Chittagong, in his 'Thank You' speech, express that Loreto's unique contribution to Bangladesh, which he has not seen done in the same way before, is the imparting of values in everything that is done, whether it be in the classroom, on the stage, in the parish, or in just sharing a meal together. Well done Yvonne, Archanna, Maloti & Rani for the impact you have made in Bangladesh!
