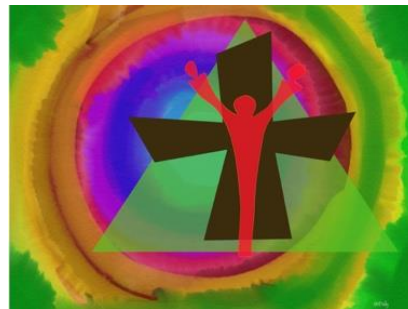

House of Prayer July-August 2019

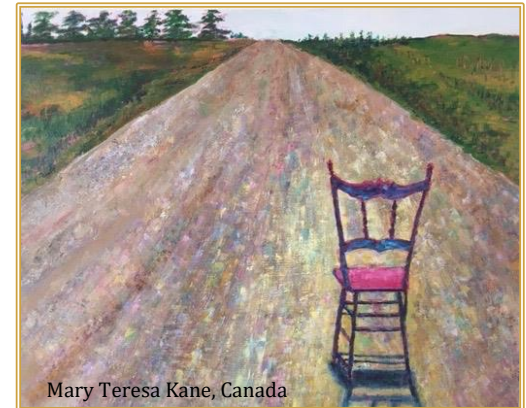

We pray with the World and the Church

- ✦ Let us pray for our governments and citizens that we will make responsible decisions to care for our people and our planet by taking steps to curb harmful practices that pollute and damage our environment such as the use of plastic bags, wasteful use of natural resources and the exploitation of persons and nature in all its forms.
- ✦ In union with the intention of Pope Francis, and remembering that those who administer justice may work with integrity, and that the injustices which prevails in the world may not have the last word. And we pray that families, through their life of prayer and love, become ever more clearly “schools of true human growth.’
- ✦ As part of the Church as the Body of Christ, let us pray that the process of preparation for the CJ General Congregation 2020 through the Provincial and Regional Congregations be lived in a climate of shared discernment, with a sense of our being a Body and with co-responsibility.
- ✦ Let us pray for the world’s indigenous peoples: “Embracing the wish of several Latin American Episcopal Conferences, as well as the requests of various Pastors and faithful from other parts of the world, I have decided to convoke a Special Assembly of the Synod of Bishops for the Pan-Amazon region, which will take place in Rome in the month of October 2019. The main purpose of this convocation is to identify new paths for the evangelization of this segment of the People of God, especially the indigenous peoples, often forgotten and without the prospect of a peaceful future, also due to the crisis of the Amazon rainforest, the lungs of paramount importance for our planet.” (*Angelus, Saint Peter's square Sunday, 15 October 2017*)
- ✦ Let us pray in remembrance of all those victims of terrorism and violent crimes that our outcry for justice, compassion, reconciliation and healing be witness to transformation in our world.
- ✦ We pray for all the people who suffer persecution as a result of a life of integrity and for those unable to express their faith in freedom.
- ✦ We pray for all people living in fear, suffering loneliness, illness, abandonment and despair, that they may experience the consolation and liberation of the Risen One and the power of the Holy Spirit.
- ✦ Let us pray for a union of minds and hearts as we grow in knowledge of our one Mary Ward Institute in the world today. Let us remember all those who have asked for our prayers, holding Companions, Friends of Mary Ward, associates, co-workers and colleagues close in our intercessions.
