

Greetings to each one of you and all the very best as we prepare for the coming **Province Days**. A warm welcome awaits you. The Province Days are a **significant meeting for the life and growth of the province and fosters the union of minds and hearts among the members.**

The Temporary Professed sisters from **Gyanayalaya** attended the workshop on "**Faith that does justice in Paschimbanga (West Bengal) today"**. Fr. Irudaya Jothi, who organized the sessions on behalf of the Conference of Religious of India said the Church's social teachings encourage Catholics to take sides with the poor. "There is a fire in the young Religious, and if the fire is kept alive, it would help them change the situation they live in," Fr. Jothi concluded.

Five Loreto sisters attended a workshop delving into the 450-year-old spirituality of St Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Society of Jesus. The workshop was organized on August
